

**VOTER REGISTRATION AND EARLY VOTING INFORMATION  
PRIMARY ELECTION MAY 11, 2010**

**VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION:**

**1. DEADLINES:**

- A) ***In Person Office Registration:*** May 3, 2010, 6:00 P.M.  
Second Friday preceding an election (32-302) [Dated moved to the following Monday due to Arbor Day Holiday]
- B) ***Registration Delivered:*** April 23, 2010, 5:00 P.M.  
Person other than the voter can deliver a registration form (32-325, 32-321)
- C) ***Mail-In Registration Form:*** April 23, 2010  
Must be postmarked on or before the third Friday before the election (32-321)
- D) ***Mail-In Registration Form with Unreadable Postmark:*** April 27, 2010  
Registration is accepted if received in County Clerk's office no later than the second Tuesday before an election. (32-321)]
- E) ***Registration at County Treasurer or Driver's License Exam Office:*** April 23, 2010  
Third Friday preceding an election (32-308)
- F) ***Registration at Agency Office*** (Dept. of Health, Dept. of Social Services, Dept. of Education, Dept. of Public Institutions): April 23, 2010  
Third Friday preceding an election (32-310)

**2. VOTER REGISTRATION APPLIES TO:**

- A) Individuals who reside in Madison County and have not registered;
- B) Individuals who have moved and need to update their address on their registration;
- C) Individuals who have changed their name;
- D) Individuals who will become 18 years of age on or before November 2, 2010

**3. VOTER REGISTRATION FORMS AVAILABLE AT:**

- A) Madison County Clerk's Office in the county courthouse;

- C) City Clerks' offices in Battle Creek, Meadow Grove, Newman Grove, Norfolk, and Tilden

**EARLY VOTING DEADLINES:**

- A) ***First day to accept early voting ballot request:*** January 10, 2010  
120 days prior to an election (32-941)
- B) ***To apply for ballot by mail:*** May 5, 2010, 4:00 P.M.  
Wednesday before the election (32-941)
- C) ***To apply for ballot by mail if person is not a registered voter:*** April 23, 2010  
Third Friday preceding an election (32-945)
- D) ***To vote in person at the Clerk's office:*** May 10, 2010  
Monday before the election (32-942)
- E) ***For agent to pick up ballot:*** May 11, 2010, 7:00 P.M.  
Election Day (32-943)
- F) ***For agent to return voted ballot:*** May 11, 2010, 8:00 P.M.  
Election Day (32-950)
- G) ***For voted ballot to be returned by mail:*** May 11, 2010, 8:00 P.M.  
Election Day (32-950)

**APPLICATION FOR EARLY VOTING:**

- A) Application must be in writing and shall indicate voter's residence address, the address to which the ballot should be mailed if different, telephone number, and voting precinct if known. (32-941)
- B) Application must be signed by voter or voter's agent (32-941)
- C) Agent can apply for a ballot and/or pick up a ballot for another person (32-943)
- D) No person serving on a campaign committee shall act as an agent, unless such person is a member of the registered voter's family (32-943)
- E) No person shall act as agent for more than two voters for any election. (32-943)
- F) Registration forms will be included with the ballot if the voter is not registered; however, registration forms can not be mailed after April 23, 2010 (32-941)
